## San Paolo Fuori Le Mura Mosaic

The apse mosaic at Basilica di San Paolo Fuori le Mura (St. Paul Outside the Walls) in Rome, created by Venetian masters between 1220-1227, depicts Christ in Majesty in the center, enthroned with saints and the apostles. This massive mosaic, partially surviving the 1823 fire, shows a divine assembly surrounded by a symbolic garden with two palm trees and an empty throne in the lower section, representing an ancient tradition.

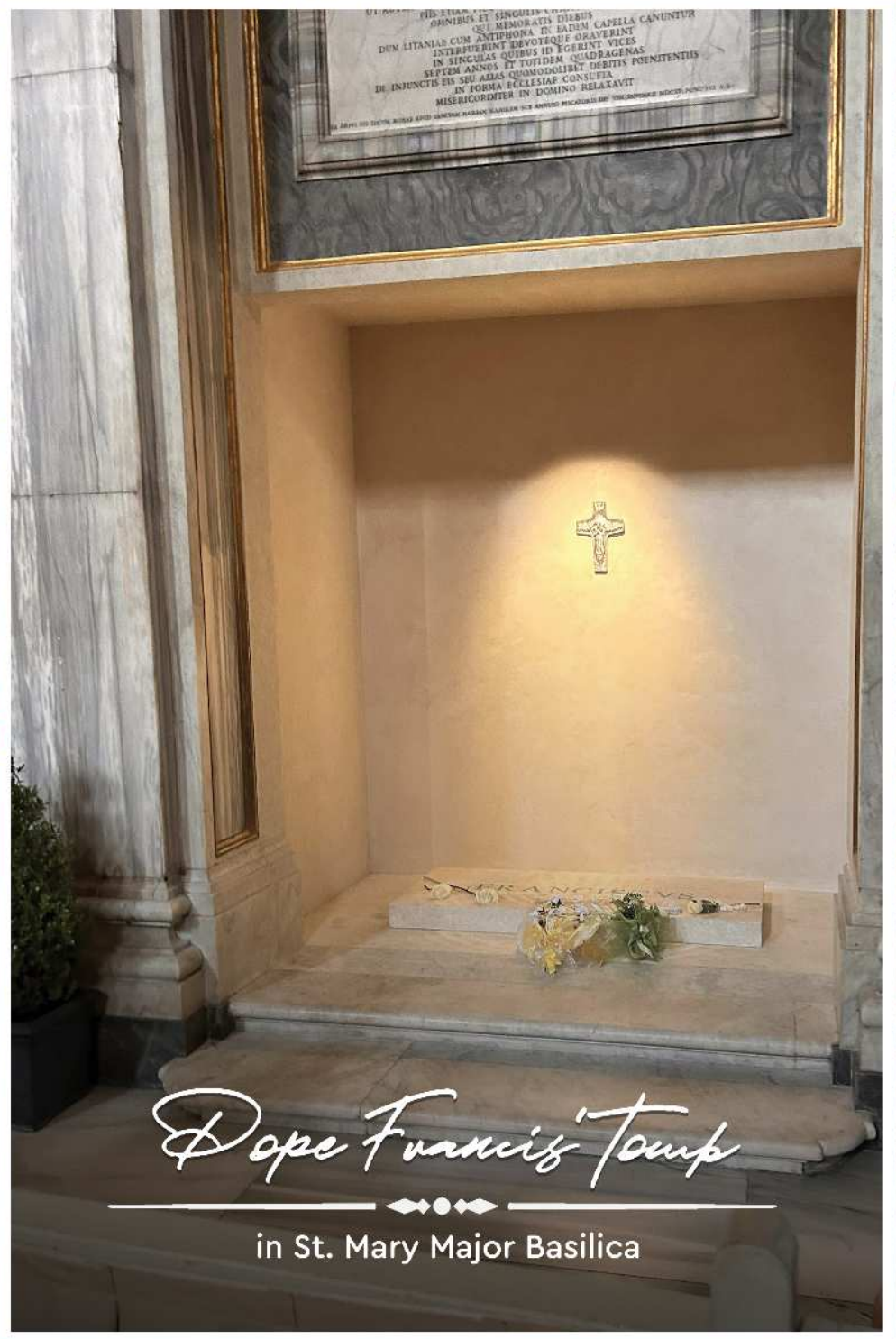

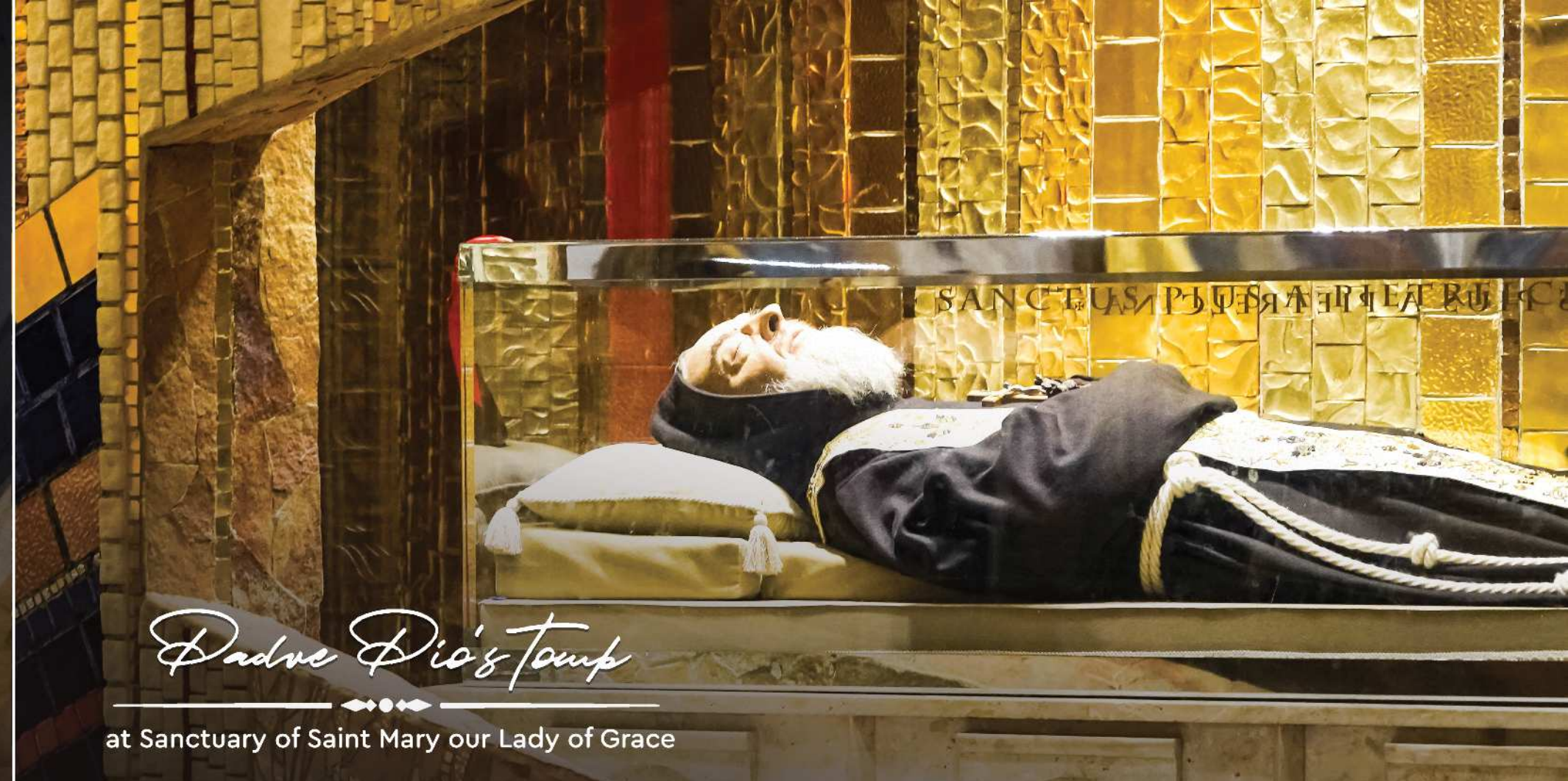

## Madonna Delle Grazie

The Madonna delle Grazie in San Giovanni Rotondo is a revered image of the Virgin Mary, honored in the Sanctuary of Santa Maria delle Grazie. Closely linked to Padre Pio, the sanctuary includes a 16th-century church and a larger modern one featuring a mosaic of the Madonna. She is celebrated annually from September 8-10, drawing thousands of pilgrims seeking grace and spiritual comfort.

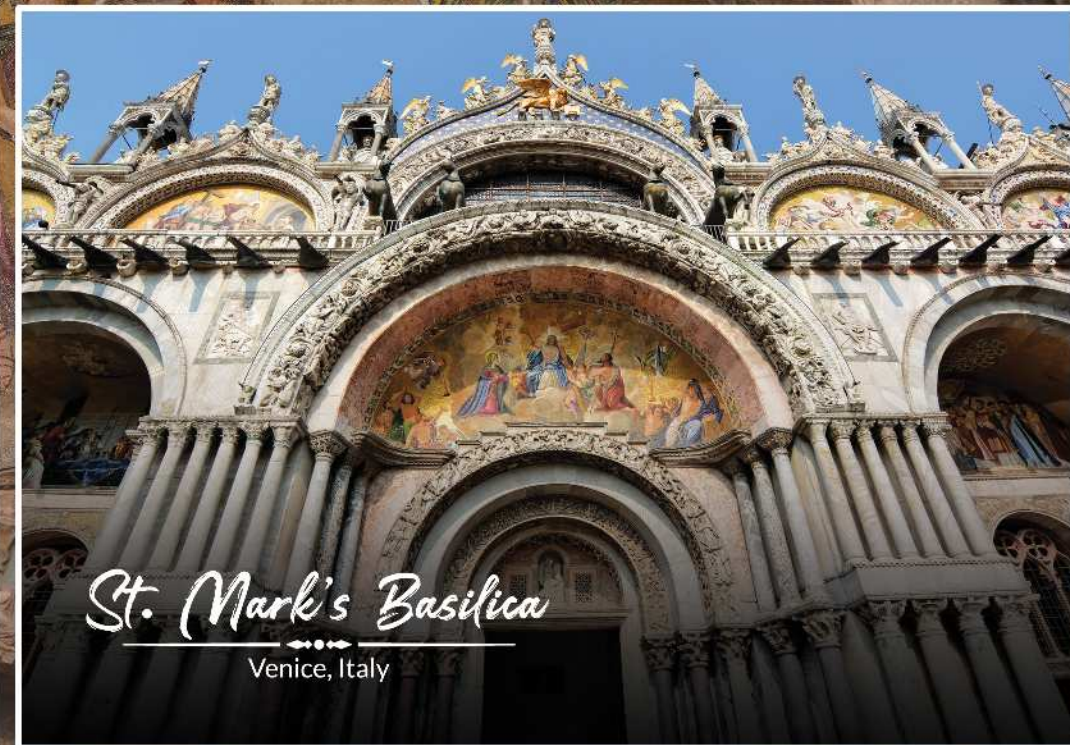


# Uffizi Gallery

The Uffizi Gallery is located in Florence, Tuscany, along the Arno River. It was originally constructed in the 16th century by Giorgio Vasari for Cosimo I de' Medici as offices (uffizi means "offices" in Italian) for the administrative and judicial branches of the Grand Duchy of Tuscany, and later transformed into a gallery showcasing the Medici art collections.

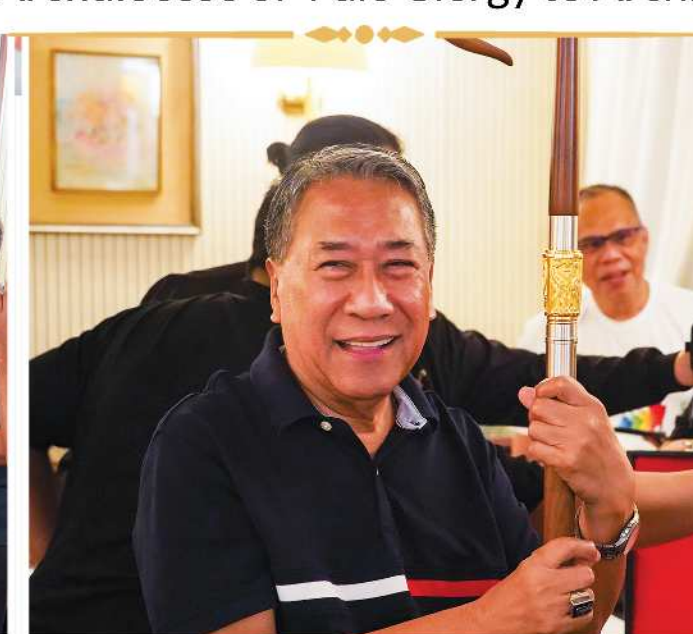
